



Archery Canada - Championship Rotation Policy

Approved by the Board of Directors on August 9, 2017

1. Policy

- 1.1. That from 2011 onward, any PSO requesting a revision to the rotation policy will not be able to swap dates without exhaustive negotiations with the Board of Directors to ensure no disruption of the policy.
- 1.2. The PSO requesting the delay must do so no later than 2 years in advance of their turn in the rotation. After that date, the PSO is required to host the Archery Canada national championships in the stated rotation.
- 1.3. The PSO requesting the delay will find a PSO willing to host the championships in the year in question.
- 1.4. There will be no change to the order.
- 1.5. No PSO may request a delay in hosting the championships more than 1 time in 10 years.
- 1.6. The Archery Canada Board of Directors will review the Rotation Policy at its annual meeting every 4 years starting in 2011.
- 1.7. The rotation is an nine (9) year cycle as follows: Ontario, Manitoba Quebec, Nova Scotia, Saskatchewan, Prince Edward Island, British Columbia, New Brunswick, Alberta

2. Jurisdiction

This policy shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario.

3. Review and Approval

- 3.1. The Archery Canada Board of Directors and Executive Director shall review this policy every four (4) years.
