### **1. MEDELLIN WORLD RANKING EVENT AND PAN AM YOUTH GAMES QUALIFIERS**

#### **1) Introduction**

---

This document serves as a Selection Addendum to Archery Canada's Compound National Team Selection Policy.

The purpose of this addendum is to define the minimum qualification scores and criteria used by Archery Canada to nominate a team of athletes to compete at the 2020 Medellin World Ranking Event and Pan Am Youth Games Qualifiers in June 2020.

#### **2) Team Size**

---

The maximum number of archers Canada can enter in each category for the Pan-American Youth Games Qualifier is:

- Cadet Compound Men: 3
- Cadet Compound Women: 3
- Junior Compound Men: 3
- Junior Compound Women: 3

**Note:** Senior Compound divisions are also contested at this event. Archery Canada can send up to 4 men and women in the senior divisions, but the selection will be limited to those named to the 2020 Senior Compound National Team. Selection for that team is outlined in the 2020 Compound National Team Selection Policy:

### 3) Process

---

The team will be selected based on the criteria for each category, as outlined below. The team will be made up of, at maximum, 3 archers per gender, per category.

**a) Cadet Compound, men & women (must be cadet aged in 2020 season, born in 2003 or later)**

Eligible archers will have attained a RED Squad level or higher in the 2019 Outdoor Target Rankings

**b) Junior Compound, men & women (must be junior aged in 2020 season, born in 2000 or later. Includes Cadets who have moved to Junior age in 2020):**

Eligible archers will have attained a Red Squad level or higher in the 2019 Outdoor Target Rankings

Junior archers born in 2000 or after are eligible to compete in the World Ranking Event. To participate in the team and individual qualifiers for the Pan American Youth Games, only archers born in 2001 or after will be accepted, as outlined in the invitation package.

**Note:** If more than 3 archers per category, outlined above, qualify, and intend to compete at this event, selection will be determined based on highest score(s) and/or ranking for their respective category. All other archers will be listed as alternates for the team.

### 4) Other Detail:

---

**Dates:** Archers intending to attend this event will need to notify the Non-Olympic Program Coordinator, [compound@archerycanada.ca](mailto:compound@archerycanada.ca), by March 20th 2020.

**Decision Making Authority:** The decision-making authority for this event includes the Non-Olympic Program Coordinator.

**Other:** This is a self-funded event, including any support staff. Interested athletes should anticipate projected costs of \$1500 - \$2000 USD per person, not including airfare. Archers should also anticipate purchase of a competition compliant uniform kit, for this event.
