



Internal Nomination Procedure (INP) For 2021 World Games: Field Archery (Recurve and Barebow)

Birmingham, Alabama 2021

1) Overview

The Internal Nomination Procedure (INP) for Field Archery at the 2021 World Games is defined by this event specific addendum to Archery Canada's 2020 Field Selection Policy, which can be found at the following link: [Canadian Team Selection Policy for the 2020 World Field Championship](#) .

The purpose of this addendum is to outline any additional eligibility requirements and event specific criteria for selection to the 2021 World Games, in Birmingham, Alabama from July 15 to 25th 2021.

Attendance at this event is determined by Quota spots allocated and won at the following qualification event:

- 2020 World Archery Field Championships, Yankton, USA

A maximum of one (1) quota places will be awarded per country per category.

2) Team Size

The maximum number of archers that Canada could qualify for the 2021 World Games is:

- 1 Recurve Male
- 1 Recurve Female
- 1 Barebow Male
- 1 Barebow Female

In the event of a discrepancy, the original WA version will prevail. In the event of changes by WA to the selection and eligibility criteria, Archery Canada is bound by these changes and will review and amend

this INP to comply with the new regulations or conditions. Amendments to this document will be communicated directly to the affected athletes and officials and posted on the Archery Canada website.

3) Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for selection for the 2021 World Games team, athletes must meet the eligibility criteria in the [Canadian Team Selection Policy for the 2020 World Field Championship](#) in addition to the following 4 (four) additional eligibility criteria, by midnight on date to be determined.

- 1) Be a Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident and well as have a valid Canadian passport that does not expire on or before January 25 2022
- 2) Be in compliance with all relevant World Archery requirements for eligibility.
- 3) Be a member in good standing of Archery Canada.
- 4) Is a member of the Senior Field National Team, competing at the 2020 World Field Championships

4) Selection Procedures

A) General

Team selection will be made pursuant to Archery Canada's Field Selection Policy, and, as appropriate, and this Addendum.

B) Automatic Selection Process

The highest ranked Canadian Athlete(s) on the World Games team that contested for and won the competition spot(s), both male and female, will be automatically selected to their respective categories for the 2021 Field team for the 2021 World Games, in Birmingham Alabama.

C) Non-Automatic Selection Process

If the highest ranked Canadian Athletes that were on the World Games team that contested and won the berth decline the opportunity to attend the World Games in Birmingham, the berth will be offered to the top 6 ranked archers on the 2020 Field Archery Ranking List, until either one accepts the berth or all options are exhausted.

D) Other

Team Size:

Archery Canada may select up to 1 archer per gender, per equipment category

Dates:

Selection for this event will be made on or before June 15 2021

Funding:

At the time of posting, funding is unknown for this event. Archers should anticipate that this event will be self-funded.

5) Withdrawal From The Team

If an athlete is named to the 2021 World Games team, but cannot attend the Games and withdraws from the team for any reason before April 15 2021:

1. The designated first alternate will be substituted and nominated to replace that athlete provided they have met any minimum performance standards.
2. The second alternate will become the first alternate.

If an athlete is named to the 2021 World Games team, but has to withdraw due to injury, illness or exceptional circumstances after June 15 2021 but before July 1st 2021:

1. They may be substituted by the first, or if necessary by the second alternate after consultation with World Archery.

6) Other Detail

Appeals:

Archery Canada's Appeals Policy will guide any appeals related to the 2021 World Games selections. The policy can be found here: [Archery Canada Appeals Policy](#). If both parties are in agreement, the Archery Canada Appeals Policy can be bypassed and the matter can be brought immediately before the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC) who will then manage the appeals process.

Decision Making Authority:

The decision-making authority for the 2021 World Games includes the Non-Olympic Program Coordinator, Sean McKenty. Oversight for the implementation of the INP resides with the High Performance Advisor.

Team Nomination and Announcement Dates:

The 2021 World Games Team team will be selected and nominated no later than June 15 2021. Changes or updates to currently published information and dates, will be provided for any affected parties
