1. Introduction

This document serves as a Selection Addendum to Archery Canada's Canadian Para-Archery National Team Selection Policy

The purpose of this Addendum is to define the event specific criteria used by Archery Canada to select the athletes, who will compete at the 2021 Para Pan American Championships & Paralympic Qualification Tournament

All references below to the 2020 Paralympic Games will refer to the Paralympic Games in Tokyo taking place from August 24 – September 5, 2021.

2. Eligibility Criteria

Team selection will be made pursuant to Archery Canada's Canadian Para-Archery National Team Selection Policy, as appropriate, and this Addendum. Eligibility requirements must be met as stated in the Selection Policy and this Addendum. To be eligible for selection,

athletes must have attained the 2020 Paralympic Minimum Qualification Score at a World Archery Ranking Event in the past.

3. Selection Authority

Under the guidance of the HPC, the National Coach is accountable to select athletes and staff, for participation at events, in accordance with the Canadian Para-Archery National Team Selection Policy and event specific criteria.

4. Selection Timeline

Selection for the Final Paralympic Qualification Tournament will be made on or before Monday February 22, 2021

5. Team Size

The maximum number of archers Canada can enter in the FPQT is three per category and additional non-travelling alternates.

6. Discrepancies & Amendments

In the event of changes by World Archery (WA) to the selection and eligibility criteria, Archery Canada is bound by these changes and will review and amend this document to comply with the new regulations or conditions.

Archery Canada is carefully following the evolution of the coronavirus on the global and domestic level and how it may impact World Archery Events and/or domestic nomination of athletes to compete at these events. Unless otherwise required by exceptional and unforeseen circumstances related to the impact of the coronavirus, Archery Canada will respect this published Selection Addendum as written.

However, situations related to the coronavirus pandemic may arise that require this Selection Addendum to be modified. Any modifications will be made promptly and as often as required following developments that directly impact the Selection Addendum. In such circumstances, any modifications will be communicated to all affected individuals as soon as possible.

Further, situations may arise that do not allow this Internal Nomination Procedure to be modified or applied as written due to time constraints or other exceptional and unforeseen circumstances. In such situations, any decision, including nomination decisions, will be made by the individual(s) with decision-making authority, as stated in this Internal Nomination Procedure, in consultation with the relevant individual(s) or committee(s) (as applicable), and in accordance with the stated performance objectives and selection philosophy and approach as stated herein. Should it be necessary to make any decision in this manner, Archery Canada will communicate with all affected individuals as soon as possible.

7. Team Selection Procedure

1. Automatic Selection

Any athlete who has attained the 2020 Paralympic Minimum Qualification Score at a World Archery Ranking Event in the past is eligible for automatic selection.

2. Defined Competition

The following Defined Competition provides an opportunity for selection for athletes not automatically selected to obtain the Minimum Qualification Score.
