



Camp Selection Procedure

Q1 2021 Defined Training or Competition Camps

Published Date: Dec. 8th 2020

1. INTRODUCTION

This document serves as a formal outline for the process used to select athletes to participate at the following training camps:

- Q1 2021 Defined Training or Competitions Camp 1
- Q1 2021 Defined Training or Competitions Camp 2

These training camps will be used as part of the selection process for the 2021 Archery World Cup events, Final Olympic Qualification Tournament and Tokyo Olympic Games.

This document will reference Archery Canada's Recurve Canadian Team Selection Policy. Although the Selection Policy is specifically intended for the selection of athletes to international competitions it will also be referenced in the selection of athletes for these camps.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Eligibility requirements must be met as stated in the Recurve Canadian Team Selection Policy and the Tokyo Olympic Games Internal Nomination Procedure, excluding the Minimum Qualification Score requirements under 5.2(c).

3. SELECTION PROCESS

A) Automatic Selection

Male athletes who have shot a registered 720 score equal to or greater than 640, between January 1st 2019 and January 31st 2021 will automatically be eligible to compete at the selection camps.

B) Non-Automatic Selection

Male athletes who have not achieved the minimum score in the defined timeline as outlined above may apply to be considered for participation in the selection camp(s).

Applicants will be assessed based on Future Potential, as outlined in section 4.1.4 of the Recurve Canadian Team Selection Policy:

4.1.4) Future Potential – The role an event may play in the development of a specific athlete who has demonstrated key qualities that are indicative of strong future potential. These qualities may include but are not limited to: talent, commitment, and performance and progression history.

4. REGISTRATION PROCESS

To participate, all athletes are required to complete the online registration form by January 15th, 2021.

Upon its discretion, Archery Canada may subsequently contact eligible athletes registering under the Non-Automatic selection process for further information to support their application.

5. Dates

Due to the ongoing challenges created by COVID-19, dates for the two selection camps have yet to be finalized. The camps are tentatively scheduled for the second halves of February and March.

6. Discrepancies & Amendments

Archery Canada is carefully following the evolution of the coronavirus on the global and domestic level and how it may impact World Archery Events and/or domestic nomination of athletes to compete at these events. Unless otherwise required by exceptional and unforeseen circumstances related to the impact of the coronavirus, Archery Canada will respect this published Camp Selection Process as written.

However, situations related to the coronavirus pandemic may arise that require this Selection Process to be modified. Any modifications will be made promptly and as often as required following developments that directly impact the Selection Process. In such circumstances, any modifications will be communicated to all affected individuals as soon as possible.

Further, situations may arise that do not allow this Selection Process to be modified or applied as written due to time constraints or other exceptional and unforeseen circumstances. In such situations, any decision, including nomination decisions, will be made by the individual(s) with decision-making authority, as stated in this Selection Process, in consultation with the relevant individual(s) or committee(s) (as applicable), and in accordance with the stated performance objectives and selection philosophy and approach as stated herein. Should it be necessary to make any decision in this manner, Archery Canada will communicate with all affected individuals as soon as possible.

7. Other Detail & Covid-19 Protocol

Archery Canada reserves the right to limit the number of participants at the selection camps.

In addition to paying incidental costs, successful applicants should anticipate a levy to cover their costs to participate in the selection camp(s).

The location for the camps is anticipated to be in South Western Ontario. All athletes will be required to reside in a hotel chosen by Archery Canada and follow Covid-19 protocols as laid out by Archery Canada.

The camps will be run according to the best practices for COVID-19 safety as generally accepted within the Canadian sporting community. Athletes travelling to participate in the camps should anticipate a requirement to self-isolate for a defined period of time in the designated hotel, and preceding the camps. Any Covid-19 testing protocols will be communicated prior to the camps within a reasonable timeframe.
