1) Introduction

This document serves as a Selection Addendum to Archery Canada's (AC) Recurve National Team Selection Policy.

The purpose of this Addendum is to define the event specific criteria used by AC to select male athletes who will compete at the 2021 World Archery Championships, in Yankton South Dakota.

2) Performance Objective

AC's central high-performance objective is to create sustainable podium potential at the Olympic Games and World Championship level. As events may have different impacts on the ability to achieve this stated objective, selections and associated investments will be made in accordance with the strategic value of each event.

For the 2021 World Championship, the objective for the Men's program is to provide a major competition as a development opportunity for athletes who demonstrate future

potential for selection to the 2024 & 2028 Olympic Games in the context of achieving AC's high performance objective.

3) Eligibility Criteria

Team selection will be made pursuant to AC's Recurve National Team Selection Policy, and this Addendum. Eligibility requirements must be met as stated in the Selection Policy and this Addendum.

4) Selection Authority

Under the guidance of the High-Performance Director (HPD), the National Recurve Coach is accountable to select athletes and staff in accordance with the Recurve Canadian Team Selection Policy, and the event specific criteria.

5) Team Size

AC may select up to three men to compete at the 2021 World Archery Championships.

6) Discrepancies & Amendments

In the event of changes by World Archery (WA) to the selection and eligibility criteria, AC is bound by these changes and will review and amend this document to comply with the new regulations or conditions.

AC is carefully following the evolution of the coronavirus on the global and domestic level and how it may impact World Cup Events and/or domestic nomination of athletes to compete at these events. Unless otherwise required by exceptional and unforeseen circumstances related to the impact of the coronavirus, Archery Canada will respect this published Selection Addendum as written.

However, situations related to the coronavirus pandemic may arise that require this Selection Addendum to be modified. Any modifications will be made promptly and as often as required following developments that directly impact the Selection Addendum. In such circumstances, any modifications will be communicated to all affected individuals as soon as possible.

Further, situations may arise that do not allow this Selection Addendum to be modified or applied as written due to time constraints or other exceptional and unforeseen

circumstances. In such situations, any decisions including nomination decisions, will be made by the individual(s) with decision-making authority in consultation with the relevant individual(s) or committee(s) (as applicable), and in accordance with the stated performance objectives and selection philosophy and approach as stated herein. Should it be necessary to make any decision in this manner, Archery Canada will communicate with all affected individuals as soon as possible.

7) Team Selection Procedure – Event Specific Criteria

7.1 Automatic Selection - Men

A) Defined Competition: AC will automatically select for participation at the 2021 World Archery Championships, any athlete that places in the Top 3, in either the Individual or Mixed Team competition at the 2020 (2021) Tokyo Olympic Games.

7.2 Non-Automatic Selection - Men

If after the Automatic Selection process, as defined in section 7.1, there are spots remaining on the team, Archery Canada may select additional athletes. In support of the stated objective of providing a major development opportunity for athletes with strong future potential, athletes meeting the below criteria will be considered for selection:

- Athletes with limited experience competing at the Senior World Championships and who have demonstrated the potential of a top 16 finish in the individual competition at the event.
- Athletes who have not previously competed at the Senior World Championships and who have demonstrated potential of finishing in the top half of the field at the event in individual or team competition.

Note: Athletes considered for selection will be assessed based on the below items:

A) Future Potential: As per the Selection Policy and defined for the purposes of this addendum, athletes will be evaluated on the following 2 elements:

1. Talent: Technical ability supporting future performance progression to support Archery Canada's stated Performance Objectives.

2. Progression History: Podium Pathway evaluation based on the Archery Canada Podium Results Track (PRT).

B) Past Performance: As per the Selection Policy and defined for the purposes of this addendum, athletes will be evaluated based on the following element:

1. Performance History: since January 1st 2019 in any observed, recorded or registered performance in international and domestic competition or training environments.

C) Team Dynamics: As per the Selection Policy and defined for the purposes of this addendum, athletes will be evaluated based on the following 2 elements:

1. Program Contribution: Individual behaviours observed, which support the creation of a positive team environment by contributing or detracting from creating a culture and environment for optimization of performance during the 2024 Paris Olympic Quadrennial.

2. Team Competition: Athlete's ability to enhance performance potential in a team event.

8) Funding

The funding levels for this event have not yet been confirmed. In addition to paying incidental costs, athletes should be prepared to pay a levy.

9) Other

Team selection for this event will be announced on or before August 30th, 2021.
