INTERPODIA FEES

Below is a summary of Fee's associated with the new Interpodia Membership System:

The set up costs of the system are being covered entirely by Archery Canada. Annually Archery Canada will pay the system license fee for the use of Interpodia. Included in this is:

- 50 hours of support, configuration and training (ignoring set up) per annum per PTSO/NSOBeyond
- 50 hours of support, configuration and training per annum per PTSO/NSO is \$50 per hour*
- *All development requested by PTSO/AC would be quoted and approved in a separate addendum at \$95.00 per hour

INTERPODIA FEES

The following outline the ongoing fees associated with the system. It will be up to the PTSO if the following will be charged to the user or paid by the PTSO:

- Membership transactions: 5% of transaction fee + \$0.30 (represents Credit card processing fees of 2.9% plus \$0.30 with WePay and 2.1% paid to Interpodia)
- Starting in 2021-22 there will be a fee of \$0.35 for the issuance of the annual digital wallet "card" (no additional charge for PDF)
- Event Transaction (an event can be a clinic, tournament or other registration) 5% of transaction
- Plus \$1 per registrant which is paid to Interpodia and a proposed \$0.25 levy to Archery Canada

INTERPODIA FEES

For the above, registrants have the option of doing an offline payment (e.g. cheque) which would be processed with a \$1.50 fee instead of the 5%

Refunds are charged \$3 processing fee
