### ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

The qualification slot is allocated to the NPC, not to an individual athlete. In the case of a Bipartite Commission Invitation the slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the NPC.

### MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC

An NPC can be allocated a maximum of one (1) qualification slot per individual medal event, for a total of six (6) qualification slots. Exceptions may be made via the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.

### ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- be internationally classified in an eligible Sport Class with a Sport Class Status of (i) Confirmed; or (ii) Review with a Fixed Review Date after 31 December 2023.

## MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) eligible athlete per individual medal event, athletes must be entered in the medal event in which the slot was obtained. Exceptions may be made for Bipartite Invitation recipients.

An NPC automatically enters a maximum of one (1) team comprised of one (1) eligible male and one (1) eligible female athlete if they have athletes competing in both genders. Team members are selected from the athletes who compete in the individual events. In principle the highest ranked male athlete and the highest ranked female athlete will be considered as the team, but the team composition can be modified up to 15 minutes before the start of the first team match.

## QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Qualification slots will be allocated in the following order:

### **TIMELINE**

22-27 November 2022	Para Pan American Championships, Santiago, Chile
4 December 2022	World Archery notifies in writing to the NPCs the allocation of qualification slots from Para Pan American Championships and Host Country slots
13 December 2022	Start of the Bipartite Commission Invitation application process
15 January 2023	NPCs confirm in writing to World Archery the use of allocated qualification slots from Para Pan American Championships and Host Country slots
1 February 2023	Deadline for NPCs to submit applications for Bipartite Commission Invitations
20 February 2023	World Archery notifies in writing to the NPCs the allocation of Bipartite Commission Invitation slots and the reallocation of all unused qualification slots
20 August 2023	Deadline for Santiago 2023 Organising Committee to receive accreditation application forms submitted by NPCs ("Accreditation Long List")
28 October 2023	Deadline for Santiago 2023 Organising Committee to receive sport entry forms submitted by NPCs

### **CONFIRMATION PROCESS OF ALLOCATED SLOTS**

By 15 January 2023 each NPC must confirm to World Archery in writing (fax and email are accepted) the number of qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their slots and World Archery may reallocate them.

By 20 February 2023 World Archery will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 20 February 2023 it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated slots for the Santiago 2023 Parapan American Games. Any NPC that does not use its allocated slots may be subject to sanctions by the IPC.

### **REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS**

Any qualification slot allocated and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated via the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.
