



## **Compound Selection Addendum**

### **2022 Pan American Championships**

Santiago, Chile

November 21- 27, 2022

#### **1. INTRODUCTION**

This document serves as a Selection Addendum to Archery Canada's Compound Canadian Team Selection Policy.

The purpose of this Addendum is to define the event specific criteria used by Archery Canada to select the Compound athletes, who will compete at the 2022 Pan American Championships.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Team selection will be made pursuant to Archery Canada's Compound Canadian Team Selection Policy, as appropriate, and this Addendum. Eligibility requirements must be met as stated in the Selection Policy and this Addendum.

### 3. SELECTION AUTHORITY

Under the guidance of the HPC and the Compound Technical Leadership Team, the Compound Program Coordinator is accountable to select athletes and staff, for participation at events, in accordance with the Compound Canadian Team Selection Policy and event specific criteria.

#### **Selection Timeline**

Selection for the 2022 Pan American Championships will be made following the eligibility period deadline of September 26<sup>th</sup> and no later than September 30, 2022.

### 4. TEAM SIZE

The maximum number of compound archers Canada can enter in the event is four athletes per gender.

### 5. DISCREPANCIES & AMENDMENTS

In the event of changes by World Archery (WA) to the selection and eligibility criteria, Archery Canada is bound by these changes and will review and amend this document to comply with the new regulations or conditions.

Archery Canada is carefully following the evolution of the coronavirus and other infectious diseases, on the global and domestic level and how it may impact World Archery Events and/or domestic nomination of athletes to compete at these events. Unless otherwise required by exceptional and unforeseen circumstances related to the impact of these diseases, Archery Canada will respect this published Selection Addendum as written.

However, situations related to the infectious disease may arise that require this Selection Addendum to be modified. Any modifications will be made promptly and as often as required following developments that directly impact the Selection Addendum. In such circumstances, any modifications will be communicated to all affected individuals as soon as possible. Further, situations may arise that do not allow this selection addendum to be modified or applied as written due to time constraints or other exceptional and unforeseen circumstances. In such situations, any decision, including nomination decisions, will be made by the individual(s) with decision-making authority, as stated in this selection addendum, in consultation with the relevant individual(s) or committee(s) (as applicable), and in accordance with the stated performance objectives and selection philosophy and approach as stated herein. Should it be necessary to make any decision in this manner, Archery Canada will communicate with all affected individuals as soon as possible.

### 6. TEAM SELECTION PROCEDURE – EVENT SPECIFIC CRITERIA

#### **6a. Priority One Selection**

2022 Senior National Compound Team athletes who attain their respective Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) at one (1) Event\* or at three (3) Archery Canada Registered 720 Round Events between April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, and September 26, 2022 will be eligible for selection.

**Minimum Qualifying Score**

- Compound Women – 670
- Compound Men – 690

\* ‘Major Event’ Definition – Canadian National Events (Canada Cup East & West, Canadian Championships), USA Archery USAT Events, and World Archery Ranking Events.

In the event there are more eligible athletes than spots, athletes will be ranked using the Average Arrow Value of their eligible scores.

**6b. Priority Two Selection**

Following priority selection one, if there are more spots than eligible athletes, Archery Canada may select athletes from the 2023 Senior Target Compound ‘Squad Selection Ranking List’ in order of current ranking as of September 26, 2022.

## 7.Funding

The approximate estimate for travel per athlete to this event is \$2,850.00. Please note, this estimate may be subject to change.

Archers named to the team will be funded in two tiers per gender category:

- Tier 1: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked eligible athletes – Funding support max 75% of estimated event cost
- Tier 2: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> ranked eligible athletes – Funding support max 55% of estimated event cost

Athletes selected using the priority two selection process cannot be ranked higher by score (AAV) than athletes selected using the priority one selection process.
