1. Purpose

This document serves as a selection addendum to Archery Canada’s Compound National Team Selection Policy. The purpose of this addendum is to select athletes to the Senior Target Compound National Squad who will be named to Team Canada at World Archery (WA) Outdoor Target events in the 2024 Calendar Year.

2. Eligibility Requirements for the 2024 Senior Compound National Squad

Team selection will be made pursuant to Archery Canada’s Compound National Team Selection Policy, as appropriate, and this Addendum. Eligibility requirements must be met as stated in the Selection Policy and this addendum.

3. Squad Size

The number of archers to be selected for the Men’s and Women’s Senior National Squad is as follows:

- Men’s Senior Squad: 8
- Women’s Senior Squad: 8

4. Team Selection Process

Athletes will be selected to squads based on the ‘Squad Selection Ranking List’ as of November 27, 2023.



The squad will be made up of the top 8 ranked male and female archers from the ‘Squad Selection Ranking List’.

Minimum Average Arrow Value (AAV): Eligible 720 scores for the ‘Squad Selection Ranking List must meet or exceed the following Minimum Qualifying Score equivalent listed below:

- **Men: 9.6 or higher (691)**
- **Women: 9.33 or higher (672)**

To meet eligibility for the Squad Selection Ranking List, archers must submit the following:

One (1) ‘Major Event’* 720 Round Score or One (1) ‘Local Event’** 720 Score that meets or exceeds the MQS AAV of 9.6 (691) for men or 9.33 (672) for women.

Athletes will be ranked on the ‘Squad Selection Ranking List’ in order based on their highest submitted eligible 720 score plus any additional match play performance points earned between April 14th 2023, and November 22nd, 2023.

Match Play Performance Points

Athletes are eligible to submit up to three (3) Match Play Scores from ‘Major Events’ to obtain a maximum of 15 additional performance points. Match Play Performance Points will be added to the athlete's 720 round score. The following chart outlines potential performance points earned based on matchplay score submission:

Event Definitions

*Major Events - Archery Canada National Outdoor Target Events - Canada Cup(s) & Outdoor Target National Championships, USA Archery USAT Events, World Archery World Ranking Events.



**Local Events - Nationally Sanctioned (registered) Archery Canada or World Archery member national association (e.g., USA Archery) 720 Round.

Intent

For all athletes not currently named to the 2023 National Compound Squad who would like to be considered for selection to the 2024 National Compound Squad, they must register their intention by October 2, 2023. Any eligible scores shot after the intent registration, and that exceed any prior submitted scores, must be emailed to the Compound Program Coordinator, Ryan Van Berkel at rvanberkel@archerycanada.ca on or prior to November 27, 2023, and copy Archery Canada Program Manager Kyla Cawley at: kcawley@archerycanada.ca.

All 2023 National Compound Squad athletes will be automatically added to the 2024 National Compound Squad Selection Ranking List.

Squad Selection

The prospective team will be announced no later than December 4, 2023, archers will have until December 15, 2023, to challenge any of the selected archer's placings on the 'Squad Selection Ranking List'

Archers selected to the 2024 Senior Target Compound Squad are the athletes eligible in the calendar year of 2024 to be named to a Senior International Compound Teams. Senior International Team Selection may be determined by event-specific selection addendums.

In any case, where an event-specific selection addendum is not published, the top four (4) ranked athletes will have priority in selection. If one (1) of the top four (4) archers declines a spot on a team, that position will go to the next archer until the 8th position is exhausted.

The selected archers will be required to sign the athlete's agreement for 2024, as well as complete and submit all appropriate athlete documentation to the Archery Canada office.

Archers will also be expected to proactively communicate with leadership their 2024 competition and training plan/schedule.

5. Performance

Selected archers will be expected to compete at Archery Canada National Tournaments, specifically, one (1) Canada Cup (East or West) and the Canadian Outdoor Target Championships. Additional performance expectations may be included in event-specific selection addendums.



In the event an athlete cannot attend Archery Canada National Tournaments, they are expected to request an exemption from leadership and communicate the rationale for their absence at least 21 days in advance of the event.

6. Removal or withdrawal from the team

Archers may be removed from the 2024 Senior Target Compound Squad if they have not met the above performance expectation without just cause and/or failed to sign the 2024 Athlete Agreement.

If an archer in contention for the team voluntarily withdraws their name from contention before the official selection date, the next archer on the ranking list, that meets the outlined criteria, will be eligible for selection.

If an archer in contention for the team voluntarily withdraws their name from the team, following official selection to the team, the Compound Coordinator can nominate the next ranked archer on the 'Squad Selection Ranking List' to the Archery Canada High-Performance Committee. The Committee will determine if that archer meets selection requirements, as per the Compound Canadian Team Selection Policy and this addendum. If HPC finds the archer does meet the requirement, they will be able to move the nomination for approval by a Selection Approval Panel, as per sections 4 & 5 of the Compound Canadian Team Selection Policy. This panel will consist of:

- 1 Archery Canada Board Member
- 1 Member of the High-Performance Committee
- 1 Neutral Party

7. Other:

Dates: Selection for this team will be named by December 4, 2023

Appeals: Archery Canada's Appeals Policy will guide any appeals related to the 2023 Senior Target Compound Squad Selection Addendum. The policy can be found here: <http://archerycanada.ca/wp-content/uploads/2019/07/Appeal-Policy-Updated.pdf>

If both parties are in agreement, the Archery Canada Appeals Policy can be bypassed and the matter can be brought immediately before the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC) who will then manage the appeals process.



Decision-Making Authority: The decision-making authority for the 2024 Senior Target Compound Squad Selection Addendum includes the Compound Coordinator and the Selection Approval Panel as laid out in Archery Canada's Selection Policy and this addendum.
