\*Except for countries that have already qualified athletes who were gold medal winners at the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games. These countries may have an additional place for the qualified athlete.

## Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form. All participating athletes must be at least 14 years old; that is, athletes born until 2013 or before.

## ASU 2025 quotas

The following athletes are the gold medalists who qualified directly at the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games:

Panam Sports awards a quota to the gold medal winner of each individual event of the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games. The quota is for the athlete, not the country. If the champion of Asuncion cannot attend the Lima 2027 Games, his/her quota will not be reallocated to any other athlete or country.

The gold medal winners in the **compound** categories in Asuncion will participate in the individual competition in Lima 2027. They can also join other archers from their countries to compete in the women's, men's and mixed team events.

The gold medal winners in the **recurve** categories in Asuncion will compete in Santiago under the following conditions:

- If they represent countries that did not earn team places for Lima 2027, they can participate in the individual competition, even if their inclusion leads the country to have two archers in the category in question. If this happens, the elimination round would begin with a 1/32 match.
- If they represent countries that have qualified a full team in that category, they will start the qualifying round and may be chosen for the team rounds of their gender or mixed teams. They will be able to continue in the Individual Olympic Round only if their countries choose them as one of the three archers who will compete individually for medals or places for the Olympic Games. In this case, the individual round would start at the 1/16 stage since only 32 athletes would advance.

Athletes who won a quota at the Junior Pan American Games can compete to earn team places for their countries in the other qualification events, but not to obtain one more individual quota for their countries.

## Qualification system

The present Qualification System has been designed to ensure 8 recurve teams of each gender, 6 compound teams of each gender, as well as the participation of individual archers from as many countries as possible. For this reason, an NOC can qualify either a 3-archers team or just one archer. A country cannot participate with two archers in one category, except if one of the archers qualified at the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

The system has been designed considering Panam Sports' request to award quotas at the Santa Fe 2026 South American Games and the Santo Domingo 2026 Central American and Caribbean Games.

The first quotas for Lima 2027 were earned by the individual gold medalists of each category in the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

With the exception of the quotas earned in Asuncion 2025, which are for the athletes who won gold medals, the quotas earned in the remaining qualification tournaments will be awarded to the country, not the athletes.

### The participants by category in the Pan American Games will be:

- Recurve Women: 33 (8 teams + 8 individual archers from 8 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games)
- Recurve Men: 33 (8 teams + 8 individual archers from 8 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games)
- Recurve Mixed Teams: As many teams as countries that qualified at least one man and one woman.
- Compound Women: 18 (6 two-member teams + 5 individual archers from 5 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Junior Pan American Games).
- Compound Men: 18 (6 two-member teams + 5 individual archers from 5 different countries + the gold medal winner of the Pan American Junior Games).
- Compound Mixed Team: As many teams as countries that qualified at least one man and one woman.

### Quotas for Peru as host country:

As host country, Peru receives the following quotas:

- 3 for the men's recurve event
- 3 for the women's recurve event
- 1 for the men's compound event
- 1 for the women's compound event



Peru will be able to earn team quotas for the men's and women's compound events in the qualification tournaments that award team quotas.

**Pan American Championship, Tlaxcala, Mexico**

- Recurve men: 18 spots
  - The top five teams of the team match play round (15). If Peru ranks in the top five, the sixth-ranked team will qualify.
  - The top three (3) individual archers of a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included.
  - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers but can only earn one individual spot for the country.
- Recurve women: 18 spots
  - The top five teams of the team match play round (15). If Peru ranks in the top five, the sixth-ranked team will qualify.
  - The top three (3) individual archers of a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included.
  - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers but can only earn one individual spot for the country.
- Compound men: 9 spots
  - The top four teams in Match Play Round (8 spots)
  - One (1) individual archer in a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included.
  - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers.



- Compound women: 9 spots
  - The top four teams in Match Play Round (8 spots)
  - One (1) individual archer in a separate round in which the countries that won team spots will not be included.
  - Each country eligible to compete in the individual qualifier can enter up to three archers.

### North American Qualifier - During the 2026 Pan American Championship

- Recurve Men (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer (1) of this geographical region from a country that did not earn a team or individual position for the Pan American Games in the qualification event. To qualify for North America, the archer must be ranked in the top 8 positions in the special individual qualifier for the Pan American Games. If the North American countries earn the possible spots in the team round or in the special individual qualifier round of the Pan American Championship, or if they were not able to place an athlete among the top 8 in the special individual round, the North American spot will be allocated with an option for all countries on the continent to the second country on the results list of the special individual qualifying event for the Games held at the Pan American Championships in Tlaxcala.
- Recurve Women (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer (1) of this geographical region from a country that did not earn a team or individual position for the Pan American Games in the qualification event. To qualify for North America, the archer must be ranked in the top 8 positions in the special individual qualifier for the Pan American Games. If the North American countries earn the possible spots in the team round or in the special individual qualifier round of the Pan American Championship, or if they were not able to place an athlete among the top 8 in the special individual round, the North American spot will be allocated with an option for all countries on the continent to the second country on the results list of the special individual qualifying event for the Games held at the Pan American Championships in Tlaxcala.

As the North American region's number of countries is smaller compared to the number of South American and Central American and Caribbean countries, no separate positions will be allocated to North America for the men's and women's compound events.



## Central American and Caribbean Games, Santo Domingo, July 2026

- Recurve Men (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.
- Recurve Women (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.
- Compound Men (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.
- Compound Women (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the Central American & Caribbean Games to be eligible for this spot.

## South American Games, Santa Fe, Argentina

- Recurve Men (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the South American Games to be eligible for this spot.
- Recurve Women (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the South American Games to be eligible for this spot.
- Compound Men (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the South American Games to be eligible for this spot.

- Compound Women (1 spot)
  - To the highest ranked individual archer from a country that did not earn a spot at the 2026 Pan American Championships. The archer must be ranked among the top 8 positions of the Individual Olympic Round at the South American Games to be eligible for this spot.

### The last qualifier

- Recurve Men (8 spots)
  - 6 spots for the top two teams in a match play round involving only the countries that did not earn team spots at the Pan American Championships.
  - 2 individual spots in a special individual match play round for qualification for the Pan American Games. In this round only the archers (maximum three per country) from countries that have not earned team or individual quotas in any of the previous qualification events can participate. The number of individual spots to be allocated can be increased to 4 if the countries that earned team spots in the last qualifier had already won individual positions in previous qualifiers. No country can earn more than one individual position for any category including the results of all qualifiers, with the exception of the spot earned in Asuncion 2025, which is additional.
  
- Recurve women (8 spots)
  - 6 spots for the top two teams in a match play round involving only the countries that did not earn team spots at the Pan American Championships.
  - 2 individual spots in a special individual match play round for qualification for the Pan American Games. In this round only the archers (maximum three per country) from countries that have not earned team or individual quotas in any of the previous qualification events can participate. The number of individual spots to be allocated can be increased to 4 if the countries that earned team spots in the last qualifier had already won individual positions in previous qualifiers. No country can earn more than one individual position for any category including the results of all qualifiers, with the exception of the spot earned in Asuncion 2025, which is additional.
  
- Compound Men (5 spots)
  - The two top teams (4 spots) in a match play round involving only the countries that did not earn team spots at the 2026 Pan American Championships.

- The top archer (1 spot) in a special match play round (maximum three per country) from countries that have not earned any spot in that category. The number of individual spots to be allocated can be increased to 3 if the countries that earned team spots in the last qualifier had already won individual positions in previous qualifiers. No country can earn more than one individual position for any category including the results of all qualifiers, with the exception of the spot earned in Asuncion 2025, which is additional.
- Compound Women (5 spot)
  - The two top teams (4 spots) in a match play round involving only the countries that did not earn team spots at the 2026 Pan American Championships.
  - The top archer (1 spot) in a special match play round (maximum three per country) from countries that have not earned any spot in that category. The number of individual spots to be allocated can be increased to 3 if the countries that earned team spots in the last qualifier had already won individual positions in previous qualifiers. No country can earn more than one individual position for any category including the results of all qualifiers, with the exception of the spot earned in Asuncion 2025, which is additional.

#### About the regional qualification events:

There are countries (Colombia, Venezuela, Panama, Guyana and Suriname) whose geographic location allows them to compete both at the South American Games and the Central American and Caribbean Games. In these cases, National Federations must inform World Archery Americas before **March 31, 2026**, in which of these Games they wish to be considered to earn qualification quotas for the Pan American Games.

Canada and the United States will be the only eligible countries to earn quotas at the North America qualification event, as they do not participate in any of the Regional Games.



## Confirmation of quota places

No later than April 18, 2027, World Archery will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified.

No later than April 20, 2027, the NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to World Archery the places they will use.

## Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, WA will reallocate unused quota places to the next NOC whose athletes have been ranked on an alternate list after the second qualifying tournament. This process must be finalized by April 21, 2027.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than on April 23, 2027.

## Qualification for the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games

In the Pan American Games, 1 mixed team recurve, 1 mixed team compound, 2 women's individual recurve and 2 men's individual recurve will earn direct qualification.
